Melkora: The Thrall Princessa's Saga

Cast of Characters

Melkorka: Before being known as Melkorka, she was Princess Mæl Curcaig, daughter of King Muirchertach. Kidnapped by a roving band of Vikings while visiting the local monastery in Ireland, she is taken to Norway to be sold as a slave (*thrall*). Traumatized by this horrific experience, she becomes incapable of speech. Everyone thinks she is a mute, including the slave trader, and because of this, he tries to sell her off as soon as possible. An Icelandic chieftain buys her as a gift for his wife, and she is taken to Iceland. In Iceland, she gives birth to a son, Olaf. His father is Hoskuld.

Hoskuld Kollson: Great-grandson of Aud the Deep-Minded and Olaf the White, a chieftain of his region and married to a woman called Jorunn. They have one son named Thorlief. Although the marriage was arranged and may not be a love match, he does, however, honour her as his wife and has great respect for her management skills. He may even fear her, especially after he buys a slave while in Norway as a gift. While away from his wife, he makes the slave his concubine. They have a child together, which he names Olaf after his favorite uncle Olaf Falain.

Jorunn Bjarnadottir: Wife of Hoskuld and mother to Thorlief, and an exceptional manager of the estate, Hoskuldstadir. She does not like the slave that she has been gifted with and can be a cruel master. She becomes very jealous of any attention her husband bestows towards this unwanted woman, who appears to be mute and struggles to understand her commands.

Olaf the Peacock (Pai): Son of Melkorka and Hoskuld and half brother to Thorlief. It is well known that he is loved dearly by his father, who named him after his favorite uncle. As a young man, Olaf goes on a great adventure to Norway, where he becomes the favourite of Queen Gunnhhild. When he returns to Iceland, he marries Thorgerdur Egilsdottir.

Thorgerdur: Mother to Hoskuld and Hrut, grandmother to Olaf. After Hoskuld's father died she moved back to Norway, where she remarried and had another child, Hrut.

Hrut: Son of Thorgerdur, half brother to Hoskuld. He shows up in Iceland claiming a right to part of Hoskuld's holdings.

King Myrkjartan: The Viking pronunciation of King Muirchertach of Linster, Ireland. He is the father of Mæl Curcaig, known as Melkorka the Thrall Princessa in Iceland.

Mor: Princess Mæl Curcaig's nursemaid.
